HRD COURSE

TIME: 20 minutes. You will be working with 2 sets of 5 sheep. All elements must be completed prior to moving to next element. All gates must be returned to their original configurations by the end of the course.

15 pts. GATHER-1: Take sheep (set A) out of the trailer. Dog and handler may enter either door. Take sheep to grain pan. Handler and dog go to designated post. Dog gathers sheep to post A. Scoring ends when sheep settle at post A.

Level I – Dog may be left anywhere between post A and B, handler may be within 15 ft of sheep

Level II – Dog left at post A, handler may be anywhere between post A and B.

Level III – Handler and dog both at post A.

10 pts. OBSTACLE #1- 2: Take sheep through gate A, into field B. Fetch or drive sheep through the middle of the panels, go clockwise around panel 1, back through the middle, counterclockwise around panel 2, cross between panels again (total 3 crosses between the panels. Scoring ends when sheep are settled at gate B

20 pts. OBSTACLE #2 WARE/DRIVE – 3: Fetch or drive sheep to the opening of the Y-chute, move. Scoring ends when sheep have settled in the middle of the arena.

Level I – Handler may fetch or drive to the opening of the Y- chute, but MUST NOT enter the Y- chute. After sheep have exited Y-chute handler may fetch or drive sheep to middle of arena for settle.

Level II – Handler to remain at cone B until sheep reach the opening of the Y-chute. Handler may move to opening of Y-chute, but MUST NOT enter Y-chute. After sheep have exited Y-chute handler may fetch or drive sheep to middle of arena for settle.

Level III – Handler to remain at cone B until the sheep have exited the Y-chute. After sheep have exited Y-chute handler may fetch or drive sheep to middle of arena for settle.

15 pts. PEN WORK – 4: Leave set A sheep. Take set B sheep out of take pen, combine set A and B sheep. Scoring ends when set A and B sheep are combined.

Level I – Handler may enter and move around in the take pen to help dog move the sheep out of the pen.

Level II – Handler may enter through the gate of the take pen but should allow the dog to move the sheep out of pen.

Level III – Handler should remain at gate of the take pen to allow the dog to move the sheep out. Handler should not enter the pen.

15 pts. SORT – 5: Take sheep to gate B, holding sheep off of the gate, gate sort your first set of sheep into field B. Sheep will have colored collars on.

10pts. 5A: - DRIVE- LEVEL III ONLY: take remaining sheep to gate out into field C. Fetch or drive sheep to cone. From cone, drive the sheep between the trees and return sheep back to field A. Handler may leave cone once the sheep have passed between the trees. Scoring ends when sheep return to field A.

15pts. REPEN - 6: Handler may fetch or drive set B sheep to stock trailer, load the sheep and latch door closed. Then return to field B to retrieve set A sheep. Handler may fetch or drive the sheep to the exhaust pen.
